7 of Respondent's rights to pension benefits, elections, or survivors' benefits under
8 Petitioner's pension or retirement plan(s) to the extent that Respondent would have
9 been entitled to those benefits or elections as the surviving spouse of Petitioner.

10 5. Prior to entry of Judgment termination status, both of the following
11 shall occur:

12 A. The Petitioner's retirement or pension plan(s) shall be joined as
13 a party/parties to the proceeding for dissolution.

14 B. If applicable, an order pursuant to Section 2610 shall be
15 entered with reference to the defined benefit or similar plan pending the ultimate
16 resolution of the distribution of benefits under the employee benefit plan.

17 6. Petitioner shall indemnify and hold Respondent harmless from any
18 adverse consequences resulting to Respondent if the bifurcation results in the loss
19 of Respondent's rights to social security benefits or elections to the extent that
20 Respondent would have been entitled to those benefits or elections as the surviving
21 spouse of Petitioner.

22 7. If Petitioner dies after entry of Judgment granting a dissolution of
23 marriage, any obligation imposed by this Judgment shall be enforceable against any
24 asset, including the proceeds thereof, against which these obligations would have
25 been enforceable prior to Petitioner's death.

26 8. Until Judgment has been entered on all remaining issues and has
27 become final, this court shall have and reserve jurisdiction to award to Respondent
28 (whether out of Petitioner's share of the community property of the parties, out of

1 Petitioner's separate property, or otherwise, or, in the event of Petitioner's death,
2 from Petitioner's estate) damages or other compensation for breach by Petitioner of
3 any of the provisions of this Bifurcated Judgment (Status Only). The provisions of
4 the within paragraph are in addition to, and not in lieu of, any other remedies
5 available to Respondent for enforcement of the provisions of this Bifurcated
6 Judgment (Status Only).

7 9. Until all community property has been divided by the Court and
8 Respondent has full and complete control of his share of the marital estate or until
9 Judgment has been entered on all remaining issues and has become final,
10 whichever is later, Petitioner shall continue to be subject to all fiduciary standards,
11 duties and disclosure obligations provided in California Family Code Sections 721,
12 1100 et seq., and 2100 et seq., as though she were still Respondent's spouse.

13 10. In the event that Petitioner remarries prior to the time Judgment on all
14 remaining issues has become final, Petitioner and/or her future spouse, shall not be
15 permitted to interpose any objections under California Evidence Code Sections 970
16 et seq., (i.e., they waive the marital testimony privilege) and California Evidence
17 Code Sections 980 et seq., (i.e., they waive the privilege against disclosure of
18 marital communications).

19 11. Until Judgment has been entered on all remaining issues and has
20 become final, unless modified by an order obtained subsequent hereto, the
21 Automatic Temporary Restraining Orders previously issued herein shall remain in
22 full force and effect, and the parties expressly waive any limitation on the court's
23 authority to extend the time limit of said orders, and each of them, hereby waives
24 notice and service of the said Automatic Restraining Orders as so extended.

25 12. The Court severs and reserves jurisdiction over all other issues
26 including, but not limited to, the nature, value and extent of community and separate
27 property, the division of property, spousal support, attorneys' fees, costs of litigation,




