Except when applying for orders restraining or enjoining violence, petitioners who are minors under 18 years of age and otherwise not emancipated must have an Order of the Court appointing an adult as a guardian ad litem to act on their behalf (Guardian ad Litem Application and Order forms available at the Forms Counter).
