Narrative:							
E-1 & R-1 dispatched for a report of a person that was run over by a bus at the Burlington and Linn Street intersection. E-1 & R-1 responding code III from station 1. Battalion Chief Humston responded code III as well.							
E-1 first unit on scene with a large custom tour bus with a person trapped underneath the bus just rear of the front right steer tire. The bus, a VIP H3 - 45, with Montana plate # 4C 30843, was turning from west bound Burlington St. onto north bound Linn St. and was positioned in the intersection. Upon further investigation, it was found that the person under the bus was riding a bicycle which was also wrapped up underneath the bus. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The driver of the bus was standing on the east sidewalk and was asked if the parking brake was set. He advised yes. He was then requested to shut the bus engine off. He complied with the request.							
Battalion Chief Humston was requested to take command at which time he requested E-3 for additional manpower. It was determined that in order to remove the patient, the bus would have to be lifted approx. 4 inches. A box crib with a high pressure air bag was positioned underneath the bus just in front of the front tire. A second box crib with a high pressure air bag was positioned just rear of where the patient was located. [REDACTED]							
[REDACTED] Additional box cribs were built next to the airbags in order to crib as the bus was lifted. Once all was established, the airbags were pressurized in an alternating fashion. Once the bus was lifted approx. 3 to 4 inches, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Time of extrication was 2037 hrs.							
Battalion Chief Humston turned command over to R-1A and returned to service. E-3 retrieved personnel from the UIHC as E-1 and R-1 crews picked up equipment. Once personnel were retrieved, E-3 returned to service. ICPD started its accident scene investigation as fluid removal was facilitated. R-1 and E-1 remained on scene for a period of time for lighting purposes. Once the investigation was complete, E-1 and R-1 returned to service.
