JUDGEMENT IN DEFAULT OF APPEARANCE

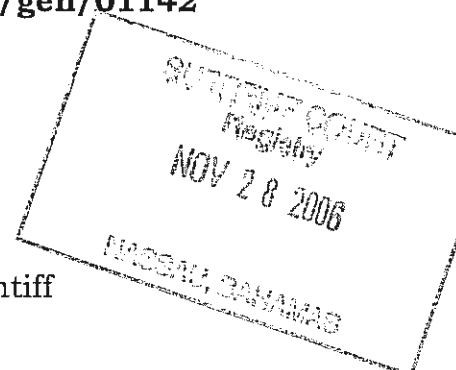
The 28th day of November 2006
